

Survey October 17 and ended October 25, 2024

Research Design: Reach 1,000 or more random registered voters, as well as more than 350 Black registered voters in each South Carolina and Georgai.

Sample gathered from South Carolina and Georgia registered voter files, as well as some from Verasight's panel of online respondents.
